TODAY'S MUSIC for the organ comes deeply from the Hebrew Traditions and holds special significance for today's celebration of The Transfiguration. When the Disciples saw the radiant Jesus with Moses and Elijah, Peter, in his awe and fear offered to make three tabernacles, better, three *Sukka* or foliage-covered booths which are most often used in the Jewish Festival *Sukkot* that commemorates the sheltering of the People of Israel in the wilderness. Along with these booths, prayers would be offered. *ADON OLAM* (*prelude*) is an ancient hymn based on Psalm 23 usually sang at the conclusion of Sabbath and most all festivals. *EYN KELOHENU* (*postlude*) is spoken or sung daily as a part of the Orthodox requirement. This rich heritage of music is closely tied with our celebrations and festivals, especially Transfiguration.
