THE SERVICE MUSIC THIS MORNING is representative of the French Classical era of organ literature. Last week, the music represented the Early Baroque period before the birth of JS Bach. Germanborn Jean-Adam Guilain (Johann Adam Wilhelmina Freinsberg) was an active composer in Paris during the first half of the 18th Century. Almost directly overlapping the birth and death of Bach, J-A travelled to France and completed his studies with Louis Marchand, a well-known organ teacher. These pieces are based on the Church Tones or Modes, which preceded key signatures in music. The Phrygian mode is very close to the modern e minor scale, with one exception - the typical F# in modern notation is played as an F natural. These pieces are well suited to our organ, which is designed not to be in equal temperament.
